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#### 新编高职英语听说教程1

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为了进一步深化高职英语教学改革,提高教学质量,培养具有中国情怀、国际视野,能够在日常生活和职场中用英语进行有效沟通的高素质技术技能人才,满足社会对人才的英语语言技能的新要求,满足学生提高自身素质的需要,编者按照教育部印发的《高等职业教育专科英语课程标准(2021年版)》,编写了"新编高职英语系列教材"。

本系列教材的编写理念是全面贯彻党的教育方针,培养和践行社会主义核心价值观,落实立德树人的根本任务,进一步夯实学生的英语基础,培养学生的英语应用能力、思辨能力和自主学习能力,为学生继续学习、就业以及终生发展奠定良好的英语基础。本系列教材注重将知识传授与价值引领相结合,着力培养学生的英语核心素养——职场涉外沟通素养、多元文化交流素养、语言思维提升素养以及自主学习素养。同时,本系列教材以中华优秀传统文化为特色内容,重视在提升学生英语语言技能的基础上,引导学生用英语讲好中国故事,传承中华文化,弘扬民族精神。

- 一、"新编高职英语系列教材"编写特色
- 1. 教材内容具有针对性和系统性

本系列教材根据《高等职业教育专科英语课程标准(2021年版)》规定的教学目标和教学要求来确定结构与内容。充分考虑高职英语教学的现状和高职学生的实际水平与需求,教材在注重英语基础知识的同时,全面培养学生的听、说、读、写、译等技能及综合应用能力。

2. 选材新颖,实用性较强

本系列教材精心选用新颖的英语材料, 语境真实, 语言地道, 教师可根据学生的学习情况选择相应的教学内容, 凸显实用性。



#### 3. 题型设置与技能竞赛以及过级考试相结合

本系列教材的题型设置切合了"高等学校英语应用能力考试(A级)"和"全国高职高专实用英语口语大赛"的题型和能力要求,有利于培养学生的英语应用能力,为学生通过考试奠定基础,也为今后参赛的学生更好地备赛作针对性的准备。

#### 4. 注重培育中国情怀和国际视野

本系列教材不仅重视学生对英语基础知识的学习和基本技能的训练,还 注重学生对跨文化知识的理解。在编写本系列教材时,编者着力将文化知识与 语言材料相融合,增加中国文化元素,增强学生对中国文化的理解和认同,引 导学生更好地传承中华优秀传统文化,有选择地借鉴和吸收外来文化。

#### 5. 设置立体化教学,满足多样化教学需求

本系列教材包含综合教程和听说教程,配套有教师用书课件、音频、微课及其在线开放课程,能更好地实现翻转课堂教学模式,更易与"职教云课堂"等新的教学形式相融合。

#### 二、《新编高职英语听说教程》使用说明

《新编高职英语听说教程》分2册,每册8单元,每单元围绕一个主题选材,中心突出,层层展开,环环相扣。第1册侧重基础英语,突出过渡性和实用性;第2册侧重与行业相关的英语,突出职业性和专业性。两册相互渗透,形成科学的有机整体。每个单元分为5个部分,各部分内容如下。

Part One Listening Comprehension:该部分为听力理解训练,按照"高等学校英语应用能力考试(A级)"的难易程度设置情境反应、对话选择和段落填空等3种类型的听力练习,旨在训练学生的听力反应和语感,从而逐步提高其听力水平。

Part Two Reading Aloud: 该部分为朗读训练,精选阅读段落,让学生反复练习,教师评价纠错,使学生掌握英语语音的发音技能,提升口语水平。

Part Three Speaking Out: 该部分为语言表达能力训练,设置与相应单元主题配套的短文,让学生在反复背诵、展示表演中举一反三、活学活用。



### Part Five Interview

#### **Qualities of Successful People**

There are several key abilities that allow successful people to fail forward instead of taking each setback personally. First, successful people don't blame themselves when they fail. They take responsibility for each setback, but they don't take the failure personally. Second, successful people don't define themselves by individual failures. They recognize that each setback is a small part of the whole. Third, achievers are willing to vary their approaches to problems. That's important in every walk of life. If one approach doesn't work for you, if it brings repeated failure, then try something else. To fail forward, you must do what works for you, not necessarily what works for other people. Finally, successful people are resilient. They don't let one error keep them down. They learn from their mistakes and move on.
